## Course Fees

## Payment Options

A \$500 enrolment fee is required to commence your Diploma of Mental Health program, which also includes access to two units of competencies. Thereafter, additional units are paid for as they are commenced. This normally occurs in blocks of 2 units but you can request access to more units at a time if required.

## Study Loans

AMA Training Services is a Study Loans accredited training provider. This course can be completed under a Study Loans arrangement by eligible students, allowing you to complete the course and pay for it over an extended period of time.

## \**Graduates of the CHC43315 Certificate IV Mental Health*

Students who have previously completed the Certificate IV in Mental Health will be eligible to get up to seven units from the Diploma of Mental Health credited to them from their previous studies. This will not only save students time in completing their Diploma, but money as well. The total value of credited units is \$1,750, meaning students who have completed all seven of these units previously will only be required to pay \$3,250 for their Diploma as opposed to \$5,000.

## Work Requirements

The Diploma of Mental Health requires students to complete a minimum requirement of 160 hours paid or unpaid work to obtain this diploma. AMA Training is unfortunately not in a position to be able to find work placements on behalf of the students undertaking this course. Therefore we recommend that anyone wishing to study this diploma should already have access to a workplace setting in order to complete assessment requirements.





## ***Entry Requirements***

There are no specific entry requirements for this qualification, though appropriate language, literacy and numeracy skills for a diploma-level qualification are expected.

Ideally, students will have current vocational experience within the mental health, aged and/or Human Resources sector.
